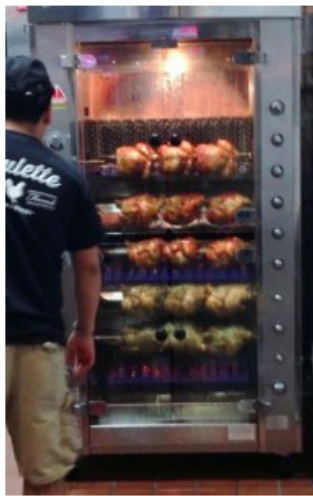


Poulette: A New Fix For Your Poulet Rôti Cravings
